St. Peter's PCCW Meeting Minutes June 7, 2021

Call to order at 7:05 pm

Prayer to Our Lady of Good Council led by Pam Benzing Secretary's Report from May 3, 2021 read by Pam. Report accepted as read. Treasurer's Report as of May 31, 2021statement read by Mary Filla. Checking \$11,028.81. Savings \$7,111.41.

Old Business:

The current SS table in the back kitchen will be moved to the front kitchen. Different options were discussed for a new stainless-steel table for the back kitchen. A suggested size for the table was 6" less wide and 12" longer than the current table. Deb Leis made a motion to purchase a 30"x 84" 18-guage stainless-steel commercial work table with galvanized legs and undershelf and casters (2 braking, 4 non), for a total cost of \$417.48. Top shelf has a weight capacity of 660 lb., and the undershelf with a 460 lb. capacity. (This is a correction of the 1800 lb. mentioned at the meeting). It was seconded by Mary Filla and passed unanimously.

Mary will write a check of \$600 to general church fund for Saturday evening organist/1 night/mo.

Ladies passed a motion last meeting to pay the remainder of the Bishop's Annual Appeal deficit after the last appeal to the parishioners was made. Mary will contact Melissa on June 21 to determine the remainder owed so it can be paid by July 1.

Continue to need new officers. Any suggestions or volunteers?

New Business:

Ladies discussed Sauerkraut Supper options and will make recommendations to the SS committee: Traditional supper preferred, but carry-out-only option a possibility. Traditional supper would have to have modifications: no family-style, have modified buffet with servers, disposable plasticware instead of silverware. Deb L. will check on prices of plates, and plasticware sets. If inside seating, then recommend having bake sale, also. No table extras. No cakewalk.

Sauerkraut Supper Committee meeting is June 15, 7 pm in church basement. All are welcome. Tentative kraut making will be Tues. August 10. A date will be decided for making coffee cakes at the next PCCW meeting depending on SS committee decisions.

An earlier suggestion to substitute Great Adventure Bible for the one currently given to Confirmation student is tabled until further information can be gathered and evaluated. Pam is to get prices of currently used Bibles from Mary Hundt.
