New Business:

Marge Lee currently gets the rectory prepared for priests and has fresh fruit, muffins or bread, coffee and snacks available. Terese Slattery has volunteered to provide a meal. Pam will talk to Fr. Biju for more information as to his specific wishes.

Sauerkraut Supper: Recommendations to Sauerkraut Supper Committee/and get other parishioners' evaluations

Carry-out dinners only—were slightly less labor intensive, ended earlier the night of the dinner, less expenses (tent, music, etc.), profit/person greater than with full dinner (*note—price for carry-out was raised to \$14/dinner from \$12.)

Pros and Cons for having full dinner—Pros: community event. Cons: labor intensive, less profit/dinner, need to change format, may not have workers needed.

Considerations for this year: (1) drive-thru dinner plus raw kraut sale, (2) drive-thru dinner, raw kraut and coffee cake sales, (3) drive-thru dinner and inside seating for carry-out portions, coffee cake and beverage sale in basement.

Other fund raising ideas were explored to supplement the money raised by the Sauerkraut Supper. (1) 50/50 raffle. Mary Filla to research license for raffles. (2) More church potluck dinners, 4/year suggested, summer and Epiphany for sure, good-will donations proposed. (3) Donuts on Sunday mornings to resume, 1 time/mo., good-will donations proposed. (4) Ask Ann Hundt re: Packer raffle possibility.

July 17, 2022 to be first church pot-luck. Deb Leis donating brats. Games at the ball-field.
