Prayer to Our Lady of Good Council

Secretary's Report – minutes from June 6, 2022 read by Pam. Accepted after correction for money to be spent on ss table and freezer. Max \$1000 for table, \$200 for freezer.

Treasurer's Report – savings balance as of 6/30/22, \$9327.99

Checking balance as of 6/06, \$14,926.66 (\$10,000 designated for general fund)

Accepted as read.

Old Business:

Received \$200 grant for kitchen upgrade from DCCW. A used 10.6 cu. ft. freezer purchased for rectory for \$200. Need for new officers—any volunteers or know possibility?

New Business:

Fr. Biju would like volunteers willing to provide a meal to any visiting priests that stay in the rectory while filling in for our priest. Father will ask the priest if he wishes a meal or snacks and will let Pam know so that she can make arrangements. The next weekend for a visiting priest will be Aug. 20-21. Marge Lee volunteers for meal, if necessary. Another possibility would be gift card for dinner at The Ridge restaurant.

Parishioners were surveyed for their choice of form of dinner for Sauerkraut supper this year, either carry-out only or carry-out with limited indoor seating, and how many were willing to help. Slightly more were in favor of carry-out only. Numbers willing to help seemed insufficient to have sit-down option.

Sauerkraut Supper Committee opted for Carry-out dinners only when they met July 5. They would like to return to seated option but agreed we needed to campaign earlier to convince people to commit to help. Carry-out price was raised to \$15, and raw kraut will be \$5/2.5 lb. Pam to order cabbage.

Parish potluck picnic Sunday July 17 after Mass: donations accepted Menu includes brats donated by Deb Leis. Deb will pick up buns. We will use the beverages that we have on hand. Ask for donations for pop and beer. Have plates and napkins. LaVonne Hundt and son James will coordinate kickball game. Pam and LaVonne will bring corn hole games. Shelter will be cleaned out Saturday July 16. Deb and Pam volunteer themselves and husbands.

A suggestion was made to pray for new parish members and renewed activity and growth. Also, ladies are encouraged to reach out to new and old members after Mass and at parish events. Let people know about activities and what they could do to help.

Fr. Biju asked if there was something that the PCCW could do for the Shermerhorn family. Three Masses will be scheduled and paid for by PCCW.

It was noted that the rectory basement was very damp and that water often runs in. Request help from parish council for solution to problem. May need new landscaping. Talk to Marge for more information.
